Re: 2003 Plumbing Registration

The 2003 plumbing registrations are due. Please complete the enclosed application and return it to this office with your registration fee of \$200.00 by the renewal date of January 31, 2003.

1. An isometric drawing must be submitted with each plumbing application.
2. To schedule a plumbing inspection, you must call between 8:00AM-9:30AM.
3. Before a plumbing inspection will be made, buildings must have proper stairs or OSHA approved ladder and in place according to OSHA regs.
4. When water tests are performed, the plumber will run the water over the roof, or leave the last joint under the roof with an OSHA approved ladder, so water test can be seen.
5. Air tests must be done with 30lb. gauge or less. (All garage and floor drains must be of approved plumbing material, be inspected, properly trapped, and installed by persons registered as plumbing contractors.) No other workmen will be qualified to do plumbing.
6. Section 4101:2:58 and 4101:2.50 of the O.A.C. will be enforced. No plastic band iron or strapping only metal or H.D. hangers are to be used for support.
7. All hot water tanks must be operating for final inspection.
8. Permits are needed for hot water tank replacements.
9. The yellow placard must be posted within 20 feet of the roadway before an inspection will be made.
10. **ALL RED TAG FEES (\$50.00) WILL BE PAID WITHIN (10) DAYS. THERE WILL BE NO FURTHER APPLICATIONS PROCESSED OR INSPECTIONS MADE UNTIL PAYMENT IS MADE. THE PERSON LISTED ON THE BOTTOM OF THE PERMIT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING FEES INCURRED.**
