

Be it resolved by the Geauga County District Board of Health, Ohio, that the ORDERS AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF WATER SUPPLIES, PRIVIES, PRIVY VAULTS, CHEMICAL PRIVY TANKS, SEWERAGE AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL EQUIPMENT, MISCELLANEOUS SANITATION REQUIREMENTS NOT OTHERWISE CONTROLLED BY LAW OF OHIO OR THE REGULATIONS OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH be amended; and that the following sections go into effect on the earliest date permitted by law:

Section 37. HOUSE TRAILER PARKS. No person, firm or corporation shall operate a house trailer park without first having obtained a permit from the Board of Health.

For the purpose of these regulations a house trailer park shall be defined as any site, lot, field, or tract of land upon which three (3) or more house trailers used for habitation are parked either free of charge, or for revenue purposes, and shall include any roadway, building, structure, vehicle or enclosure used or intended for use as a part of the facilities of such house trailer park. House trailer shall have a meaning as defined in section 6290 of the General Code of the State of Ohio.

For the purpose of defraying the expenses of inspection, fees shall be charged and collected from the person, firm or corporation making application for subject permit as follows:

For house trailer parks having capacity of less than twenty-five house trailers fifteen dollars(\$15.00); for house trailer parks having capacity of twenty-five or more house trailers and less than one hundred house trailers twenty-five dollars(\$25.00); and house trailer parks having capacity for one hundred or more house trailers thirty-five (\$35.00).

Inspection shall be in accordance with sections 1235-1, 1235-2, 1235-3, 1235-4, and 1235-5 of the General Code of the State of Ohio and regulations 260 through 289 of the Ohio Sanitary Code.
