

REGULATIONS FOR THE SANITATION OF CAMPS

IN THE GEAUGA COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT

Authority of Revised Code Sections 3707.01 and 3709.21

Section 39. WHEREAS, the Ohio Sanitary Code provides regulations for the sanitation of camps within the State of Ohio, and,

WHEREAS, the County of Geauga, State of Ohio, can anticipate the immediate establishment, operation, and maintenance of camps throughout the Geauga County General Health District, and,

WHEREAS, said establishment, operation, and maintenance of camps in the Geauga County area will require the supervision and control and authority of the Geauga County General Health District before said camps can become operative under the Ohio Sanitary Code, and said costs of supervision, control, and authority by the Geauga County General Health District necessitates the adoption of comparable regulations for the Geauga County General Health District for the purpose of preserving the public health, safety, and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that for the purpose of supervising, controlling, and exercising authority over the operation of camps in the Geauga County General Health District, and for the purposes of preserving and promoting the public health, safety, and welfare, the rules, orders, and regulations known as Regulations No. 232, 233, 234, and 235 of the Ohio Sanitary Code, and all amendments thereto, are hereby adopted and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten, and said regulations are herein identified as Section 39 of the Sanitary Regulations of the Geauga County General Health District, and are hereby declared to be emergency measures, and such orders, rules, and regulations shall become effective immediately upon adoption this tenth day of May, 1965, without advertising, recording, and certifying.

Section 39.01. All operations of camps to which these regulations apply shall only be with the express authority of the Geauga County General Health District and upon the issuance of a permit therefor.

Section 39.02. Camp permits shall be issued annually, with the expiration date of each permit being December 31 of the Year of issuance. Application for permit shall be in accordance with application forms to be submitted to the Geauga County General Health District in accordance with standard forms provided by said General Health District, and upon proof that conformity with said department's requirements, as herein adopted, have been met.

Section 39.03. Costs of said camping permits shall be as follows:
(LISTED IN 3 CATEGORIES - C I - C 5 - C 10-)

C I would pay \$1.00 per year and would be any camp that already has a food service license.

C 5 would pay \$5.00 and would be any day camp that has no food service license and no camper stays over 8 hours.

C 10 would pay \$10.00 and would be any camp not having a food license but where campers stay over nite or for longer periods.


Section 39.04. Any permit issued under the authority of this section may be revoked at any time by the Geauga County General Health District upon the finding of the Health Commissioner that the regulations for the sanitation of camps, as herein adopted, are not abided by.


Section 39.05. These regulations shall be incorporated in the Geauga County General Health District Sanitary Regulations as Section 39, under the authority of the Ohio Revised Code Sections 3707.01 and 3709.21.

Section 39.06. Any person who violates any provision of these regulations shall be subject to the penalties provided by Ohio Revised Code Sections 3707.48, 3707.50, and 3707.99.

Section 39.07. Should any part of these regulations be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of these regulations shall not be affected thereby.

Section 39.08. These regulations were adopted and passed as emergency regulations by the Board of Health of the Geauga County General Health District, according to law, and are in effect on and after May 10, 1965.
